

# Dog

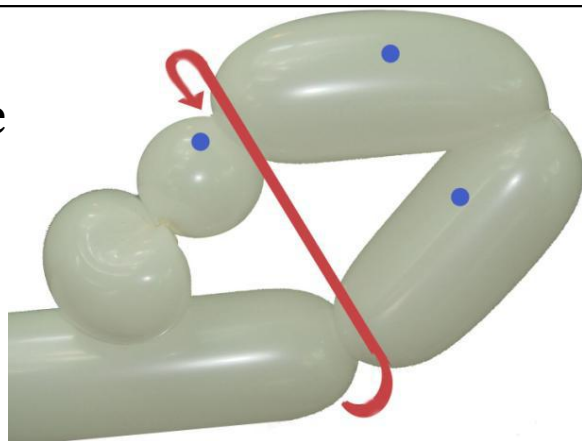

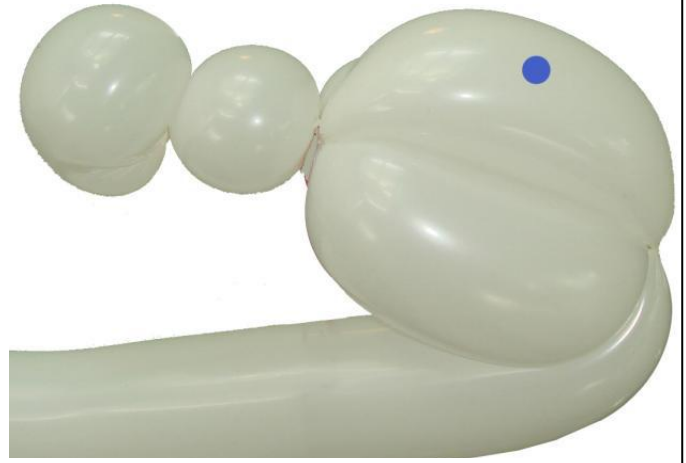
Inflate a 260 balloon leaving a 6" tip. Run your hand firmly down the balloon to stretch it. Make a soft 2" bubble and twist the lip knot into the end of the bubble to form a pinch twist. Ensure the lip knot is central, not to one side. This will be the dog's nose and mouth.



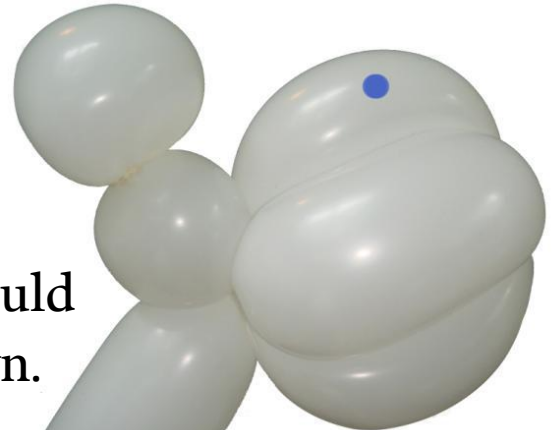
Make one 1.5" bubble to form the muzzle and two 3" bubbles. Twist the 3" bubbles together. These will be the ears.



Make another 3" bubble and extend it up over the ears to form the back of the head.



Make a 2 ½" bubble and twist it in on the opposite side at the base of the ears to make the front of the head. The muzzle should sit under the 2 ½" bubble as shown.



Continue with a 1" neck, one 2 ½" leg, two ½" bubbles for the feet and another 2 ½" leg. Lock twist the legs together.



Make one 2 ½" body, one 2 ½" leg, two ½" bubbles for the feet and another 2 ½" leg. Lock twist the legs together. The remaining balloon is the tail.



Give your dog a personality.

Of course you can also make  
it into a plaything by giving
