

Pumpkin



You will need:

3 x Orange 260

1 x Green 160

1 x 10" Round

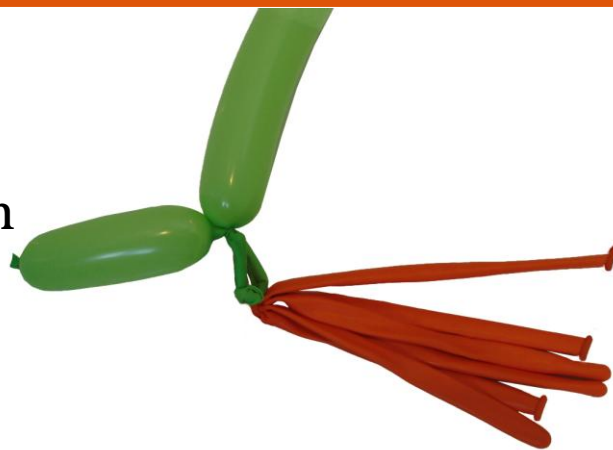
Tie a scrap of green balloon across the middle of the three un-inflated balloons.



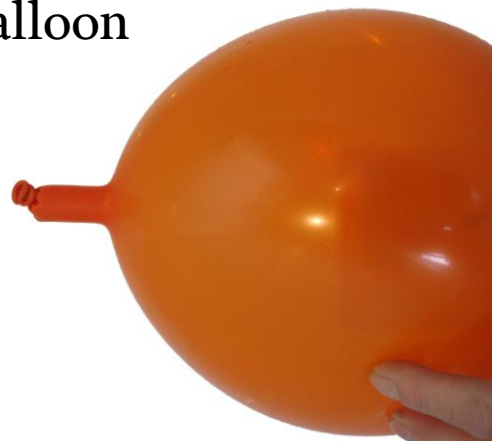
Inflate a green 160 balloon leaving a 6" tip. Make a 4" bubble.



Tie the green scrap of balloon into the 4" bubble on the green inflated balloon.



Inflate the round balloon. Tie the balloon as close to the lip as you can.



Push the air up to the lip of the balloon.



Hold the knotted bunch of un-inflated balloons against the lip of the round balloon.



Push the knotted bunch into the round balloon and catch hold of them through the skin of the balloon at the opposite point.



This is the view from the bottom.



Tie the twist in place with a scrap.



Pull one of the six lengths of balloon from the top of the balloon and tie it into the base.



Pull a second balloon from the top, taking it over the opposite side of the round balloon and tie it in at the base.



Continue with the other lengths of balloon until you have drawn all six lengths over the round balloon.



Make a 3" bubble in the green 160 balloon.



Roll the 3" bubble under one of the orange balloons. Squeeze the air up the balloon and twist the deflated length into the stem.



Repeat six times until you have a green bubble rolled under each of six lengths of orange balloons.



Draw the face. Here I drew the eyes, nose and mouth with a white pen initially and then used a yellow pen and outlined with black to give the impression of a lighted pumpkin.
