



Three bubble weave



Inflate a 160 balloon leaving a 6" tip. Make a small bubble, a 1 1/2" bubble. Another small bubble and another 1 1/2" bubble. Twist the 1 1/2" bubbles together.



Make another set of three bubbles with one 1 1/2", one small bubble and another 1 1/2" bubble. Twist the 1 1/2" bubbles together.



Make a small bubble



Make another set of three bubbles as before and twist them together.



Now make another set of three bubble as before. You should have this.



Continue making more rows with one small bubble to separate each row. Remember the more rows you have the flatter the circle will be. 10 rows makes a nice bowl shape.



When you have made as many as you like. Tie an un-inflated balloon in to the end row as shown.



Draw the un-inflated balloon inside the rows as shown, pulling the bubbles closer together.



Once you have drawn the un-inflated balloon through them all it should look like this.



Tie the un-inflated balloon into the first bubble so you have completed a circle.



Join the first small bubble you started with to the junction between the last two sets of bubbles



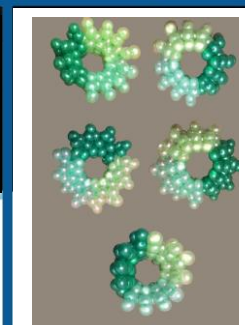
Now if you turn the top row of bubbles round you have this.



Here is the same one done in green. I took the gold one apart and concertinaed it. I used an un-inflated balloon which is threaded through it so it keeps its cube shape.



In this picture you can see more clearly what I did. There were 10 layers. I folded the 6th layer back in the opposite direction. That simple!



This is done with three sets of 3 bubbles in each row instead of two sets.
